

How to Apply for the Permit(s) RAM Defense offers:

(any of these requirements are subject to change)

- **Minnesota:**

- New:

- Complete the RAM Defense LLC COMBINED/multi-state class.
 - **Take the RAM Defense completion certificate in person to the Minnesota county sheriff's office of the county you reside in.**
 - Tell them you're there to apply for a Minnesota Permit to carry.
 - They will give you the application.
 - You can also get the application online (<https://dps.mn.gov/divisions/bca/bca-divisions/administrative/Documents/Permit-to-Carry-a-Pistol-Application.pdf>) before you arrive.
 - Do NOT sign it until in their presence.
 - Just in case that particular sheriff's dept. makes that demand.
 - They will make a copy of the class/training certificate and your official ID.
 - Pay up to \$100 max for a new application, up to \$75 max for a renewal, up to \$85 max for a renewal of an application that expired within the last 30 days.
 - The sheriff's department must issue your permit within 30 days or deny it based on requirements spelled out by law (<https://www.revisor.mn.gov/statutes/?id=624.714>).

- Same process.

- **Utah:**

- New:

- Complete the RAM Defense LLC COMBINED/multi-state class.
 - **RAM Defense will issue you a certified Utah application, a checklist of what you need to send by mail, and possibly a blank fingerprint card.**
 - Do NOT do anything to or on the fingerprint card, e.g. NO writing, stains, etc.
 - Fill out the top half of the Utah app and sign.
 - Get fingerprinted by a law enforcement agency and print on the Utah card.
 - If digital, it takes longer but you get better prints.
 - If wet ink, quicker but could get worse prints the FBI rejects.
 - Get a passport quality photograph of yourself.
 - Can use a phone app like Passport Photo Editor.
 - Can use Dean's Photo Express in Roseau or other passport photo service.
 - Make a copy of your official ID.
 - Send the application by mail with \$63.25 and the required attachments to the address on the application by mail.
 - **MN residents are NO LONGER REQUIRED to send a copy of their MN Permit to Carry as of August 2015.**
 - Can take up to 90 days to get the permit back.

- Renewal:

- Fill out the one page renewal application physical form and sign or fill it out online.
 - Include a recent passport quality photograph.
 - Pay \$25.
 - Submit by mail or online (<https://bci.utah.gov/concealed-firearm/how-do-i-renew-my-concealed-firearm-permit/>).

- **Florida:**

- New:

- Complete the RAM Defense LLC COMBINED/multi-state class.
 - Visit <http://www.freshfromflorida.com/Divisions-Offices/Licensing/Concealed-Weapon-License> and read/follow "First Time Applicants" section and instructions.
 - Save and/or print:
 - <http://www.ramdefense.com/resources/credentials.pdf>.
 - You should submit copies of the credentials as well as the completion certificate of the class you attended.
 - It will include a section to request a free blank FL fingerprint card.
 - Tip: could get fingerprinted for FL and/or UT (on the UT card) at the same time.
 - Mail these with \$97 payment.
