The 63<sup>rd</sup> Legislative Assembly made changes to North Dakota's weapons and concealed weapons laws that affect your application/license.

- Effective August 1, 2013, in order to be eligible for a North Dakota concealed weapons license, an individual must be (a) a resident of North Dakota or (b) possess a valid concealed carry license from their home state of residence, which state must have reciprocity with North Dakota. Home state of residence is determined by the applicants/license holder's driver's license.

- ☐ Accordingly, your APPLICATION for a Concealed Weapon License/Renewal cannot be accepted. The application processing fee is returned or will be refunded to you. The application and attachments have been destroyed.

**AK** Effective 8-1-2013, your North Dakota concealed weapons license is **INVALID** and cannot be used for concealed carry in North Dakota or any other state. A law enforcement status check of your ND concealed weapon license will show that it is invalid. Please destroy the license immediately.

You may wish to contact your home state's regulatory agency or officials to urge changes to the policy/law that prohibits reciprocity between our states.
